
STEP BY STEP ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS, Cont'd



Step 6 Pool Installation

Note: Two (2) people are required for installation.

Fill each of the two (2) Ballast Sand Bags with a purchased and factory sealed bag of sand. A total weight of approximately 80 lbs. is required to keep the step from moving once in place. With the assistance of another person, carefully place the step into the pool. Place the two sand bags over the Ballast Tray (D) to hold the step into place. Again, with the assistance of another person, walk back and position the step against the pool wall to prevent swim behind hazards.



Step 7 Deck Mount Installation

With the step in position close to the pool wall, slide the Deck Connectors (H) into installation position on either the pool top seat or pool deck. Secure to the deck with two (2) #8 x 1" screws (N). Use a minimum of two screws per deck connector. Now secure each Deck Connector (H) to each Upper Handrail (E1) by using a single #8 x 1" screw as shown.

- Do not swim through, behind or around the step.






STEP BY STEP ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS




Step 1 Lower Step and Riser Assembly

A second person will be of assistance in holding the side risers in place as it is being secured to the step treads. Position the Lower Step Tread (A2) on its side as shown. Align the "mushroom head" snaps with holes on the Lower Right Side Riser (C2). Once all snaps and alignment holes are in position, firmly hold down the riser and strike with a rubber mallet to secure the "mushroom heads" to the riser. Flip over the assembly and repeat with the Lower Left Side Riser (B2).




Step 2 Upper Step and Riser Assembly

Position the Upper Step Tread (A1) on its side as shown. Align the "mushroom head" snaps with holes on the Upper Right Side Riser (C1). Once all snaps and alignment holes are in position, firmly hold down the riser and strike with a rubber mallet to secure the "mushroom heads" to the riser. Flip over the assembly and repeat with the Upper Left Side Riser (B1).




Step 3 Upper and Lower Assembly

Stand the Lower Step & Riser Assembly and Upper Step & Riser Assembly in the upright position as shown. Insert the tabs on the Lower Step Tread (A2) into the slots on the Upper Step Tread (A1).



Step 4 Step Braces

Locate the Top Step Support Brace (F). Position the brace with the open side facing toward the front of the step. Be sure to position the brace so the notch on each end will align and be flush with the top side of each riser. Locate the Mid-Riser Support Brace (G). Position the brace with the open side facing down. Snap down and secure the brace over the tabs which are located in the middle back section of each riser. Snap in Ballast Tray (D) over riser tabs.



Step 5 Handrail Assembly/Deck Connector

Assemble handrail assembly as shown here. Secure upper handrail (E) to handrail connector (J) using (1) one #8 1" screw as a set screw. Secure the lower handrail (I) to the handrail connector (J) using (1) one #8 1" screw. Please note there are no holes provided.

Position the deck connector (H) around the end of the upper handrail that will be inserted into the top step handrail socket.
